The Tournament is affiliated to and governed by the rules of Tennis Ireland.

The Committee reserves the right not to hold any event where, in its opinion, the number of entries is inadequate. In such cases, grades may be combined where appropriate.

All players will be limited to 3 championships.

**Each player must check online at <http://ti.tournamentsoftware.com/> regarding when they are scheduled to play. Players will not be contacted directly regarding match times.**

Junior players (under 18) are not permitted to play with the exception of those 16 and over who may play in the top grade. Parents/guardians must accompany junior players.

All sections will play the best of 3 tie-break sets.

The Tournament Director/Committee reserves the right to demote or upgrade a player to a different grade than that which he/she entered. If you have won the event entered in last year's Club Championships, you must play at the higher grade.

Matches will be scheduled for 6.00pm, 7.15pm, 8.30pm and 10.00pm on weekdays throughout the tournament.

Matches will be played in the evenings and under lights where necessary.

Absolutely no unavailability accepted for those playing in 3 events. Only one day of unavailability accepted otherwise.

Players more than 20 minutes late for a scheduled match may be automatically disqualified.

Players must confirm presence to tournament organisers at least 10 minutes prior to the scheduled match time.

Players must wear recognised tennis apparel and shoes. No black-soled runners allowed.

The club will provide tennis balls (Tretorn Plus) for all matches.

**Finals will be played on Friday 29<sup>th</sup> September. No exceptions to this will be allowed as it is a requirement of the sponsor.**

The Committee reserves the right to alter, amend, add to or delete any of the above conditions.

In the event of any disputes, the decision of the Tournament Director/Referee will be final.
